(May 19, 2017) Gitler &_____ is proud to present Yard Sale from Canadian artist collective Team Macho. The Toronto-based group is made up of Nicholas Aoki, Stephen Appleby-Barr, Christopher Buchan, and Lauchie Reid. If there's one thing to draw from Team Macho's process, it's that artistic intent is meant to evolve, be torn down, and battle-tested until any notion of authorship is bastardized beyond recognition.

Style, medium, subject and form – these elements have a beginning and an end within their process, but more so, they are gateways to improvisation and adaptation, depending on what order in the sequence each artist receives (starts, continues, or finishes) another's work. The concept for Yard Sale introduces a new layer to the collective's customary teamwork-cum-competitive approach. Rather than receiving and swapping one another's work, the tenuous equilibrium is disrupted here with the introduction of an entirely new type of unknown: kitsch. The old, the unloved, the amateurish and overly sentimental pieces that one might sooner label "vintage" than "art" (albeit with a hint of irony) can now be transformed with a roll of the dice.
