(November 10, 2014) Gitler &_____ is proud to present *Beyond Color*, a solo exhibition of new and recent works by Korean-born, mixed media artist Zin Helena Song. This show marks the first time Song has exhibited with gallerist and curator Elliot Avi Gitler. The show opens Tuesday evening, November 18, at 6:00 PM.

Song's distinct geometric forms play with scale and color in ways that render hard-edge abstraction into fully formed three dimensional compositions. Her pop sensibilities come through in how she meticulously patterns each angle, line and shift, and yet it's the unique shape of each piece, juxtaposed with vibrant color fields, that lends the work its character. The artist's approach is both exacting and anti-analytical, wherein fixed points will shift at seemingly random coordinates along the picture plane.

The artist was born in Seoul in 1983. She completed her undergraduate work at Kook Min University and only recently earned her MFA from Long Island University. Ms. Song lives and works in New York. She is represented on the west coast by CES Contemporary in Downtown LA.

Gitler & _____ is an art gallery dedicated to showcasing rising artists from around the world. Gitler & _____ seeks out talent through chance and word-of-mouth, moving in between genres to identify original craftsmen and visionaries who may not otherwise be brought to market.
